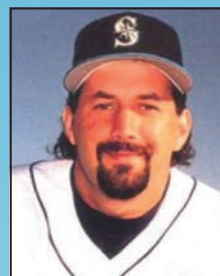

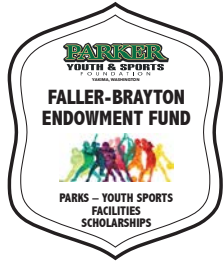

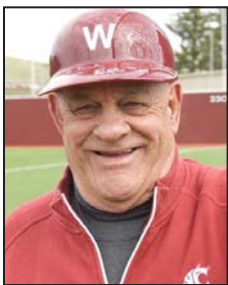

ROOSEVELT ELEMENTARY GRANT BRINGS PLAYGROUND FITNESS, FUN & COOPERATION

In September of 2022, Parker Youth & Sports presented Roosevelt Elementary with a \$5,000 grant to help fund a new physical education program and all-school training by Playworks Inc. The goals of the program are to improve fitness, increase cooperation on the playground and bring fun to recess. Likely because of the isolation experienced by students during the Covid-19 quarantine, students were staying alone on the playground and cooperative behavior was challenged. The program was initiated to re-invigorate students to play games and make cooperative decisions.

Principal Cheryl Jordan stated the Playworks Playground program has been a solid success and she



sent photographs and samples of how the program operates. They had a week long training of staff, students and volunteering parents in the fall. Students were selected from individual classrooms to be the student coaches. Teachers and parents were trained as volunteer parent coaches and supervisors. All coaches and supervisors received purple coaches t-shirts. The school received new equipment, different types of balls and catalogs with new games for playground activities. Principal Jordan extends sincere appreciation and gratitude to PYSF for the grant dollars that allowed them to bring this program to Roosevelt.

LEGENDS DINNER

"The 2019 Sport Legend Dinner will always be a special memory for me. Every year many Parker Partners work months to have a good High Hopes dinner and golf program to raise funds for the Faller-Brayton Endowment. The endowment is how we get the funds to support youth activities in Yakima County. Bob Romero was the MC of the Legends Dinner and did a great job. Special guests were introduced – Sherrie Parker, Jean Stottlemire and many past Legend recipients attended. Ray Funk, Yakima Valley College athletic director, presented PYSF's scholarships and awards to grateful YVC students."

LEGENDS HONORED

One honored Legend guest followed another telling amazing sport stories with sincerity and humor. Jon recalls, "Hall of Fame track coach Phil English, who travels all over the world and is an internationally acclaimed track coach gave an inspiring and humorous talk. Recruited from Ireland, Phil was a scholarship track athlete at WSU when the team shared the gym with Coach Bobo Brayton's baseball team. Kirk Tourtillotte introduced the 1976 YVC Championship Baseball Team and provided lively comments about team

members and Coach Bill Faller. Kirk announced that the 1976 team pledged \$10,000 to the Faller Brayton Endowment Fund. The PYSF tournament's honorary chairman, Phil Hinrichs, spoke of playing for Coach Faller and then Coach Brayton at WSU and brought applause when he spoke of the successful YVC teams he played on in 1976 and 1977 that went on a 19-1 record run.

YOUTH SPORT GRANTS

"Jerry Ward brought the program home by presenting a \$4,000 check to Yakima Grid Kids and presented the \$10,000 Daryl Parker award check to the mayor of Mabton toward the development of a new Mel Stottlemire City Park."

LESSONS FROM THE STOTTELMYRES

"The final speaker and honored guest was Todd Stottlemire – Mel's second son. Todd talked about the memories and life lessons he experienced in Yakima. He shared that during his 15 years in Major League Baseball, he only hit one home run – and he is forever thankful that his Dad and Mom happened to be at that game. Todd told of the lessons he learned from his Dad."
